Su	mmary:
	On February 10, 2016, the Fargo Police Department (FPD) responded to a domestic disturbance/man with a gun call at 308 9th Avenue North in Fargo, North Dakota. FPD Officer JASON MOSZER The subject, MARCUS SCHUMACHER, was shot by a FPD SWAT officer
	Utilizing dispatch logs, police radio traffic recordings, video recordings, SWAT logs, and other information gathered during the officer-involved shooting investigation conducted by the North Dakota Bureau of Criminal Investigation (NDBCI), in conjunction with other local and state law enforcement agencies, Special Agent (S/A) documented a timeline outlining significant events as they occurred during the incident.

Details:

(ALL TIMES ARE APPROXIMATE)

FEBRUARY 10, 2016

1. 7:02 p.m. Marcus C. Schumacher Jr. called 911 from the Sanford Emergency Room and reported a domestic dispute between his parents, MARCUS SCHUMACHER and Michelle Schumacher. Marcus C. Schumacher Jr. stated when Marcus C. Schumacher Jr. left the residence a few minutes prior to calling 911, MARCUS SCHUMACHER was at the residence with

a loaded .22 caliber rifle.

- 2. 7:10 p.m. Unit E9 (Officer Scott Normandin) and Unit E112 (Officer Jordan Michaels) advise dispatch that they have arrived at Sanford Health hospital to meet with the complainant, Marcus C. Schumacher Jr. Other responding officers begin to set up a perimeter around the area of 308 9th Avenue North.
- 3. 8:11 p.m. MARCUS SCHUMACHER calls 911 and informs dispatch that he took a shot at his wife earlier and that he is the person the police are looking for. Dispatch communicates with MARCUS SCHUMACHER and MARCUS SCHUMACHER informs dispatch that MARCUS SCHUMACHER is alone in his house.
- 4. 8:19 p.m. MARCUS SCHUMACHER fires three (3) rounds out the window of his residence. These are the first (1st) shots fired by MARCUS SCHUMACHER other than the round MARCUS SCHUMACHER reportedly fired towards his wife, Michelle Schumacher, during the domestic dispute that occurred earlier in the evening. MARCUS SCHUMACHER would continue to periodically fire shots from inside the subject residence in various directions including shots fired at the SWAT (Special Weapons and Tactics) BearCat, responding officers, law enforcement vehicles, civilian vehicles, and various structures in the area. As MARCUS SCHUMACHER would shoot from the subject residence, officers would call out "shots fired" over the police radio to notify other responding officers.
- 5. 8:27 p.m. Fargo Police Department (FPD) Detective Phil (Philip) Swan begins talking with MARCUS SCHUMACHER in place of the dispatcher that initially answered MARCUS SCHUMACHER's 911 call.
- 6. 8:36 p.m. North Dakota Highway Patrol (NDHP) Trooper Adam Malafa arrives in the alleyway on the west side of the subject residence. Trooper Malafa parks his patrol vehicle to the south of the subject residence near 8th Avenue North.
- 7. 8:43 p.m. Officer JASON MOSZER parks his patrol vehicle in the alleyway north of the subject residence near 10th Avenue North.

8.	8:57 p.m.	Dispatch conducts a status check of Fargo Police Department officers. All officers indicate they are Code 4.
9.	9:01 p.m.	The incident command post is relocated to First Lutheran Church.
10.	9:05 p.m.	Officer JASON MOSZER exits his patrol vehicle and walks southbound through the alley toward the subject residence. Officer JASON MOSZER positions himself on the north side of a light blue garage located on the west side of the alleyway.
11.	9:07 p.m.	"Shots fired" is reported over the police radio. At least one (1) round strikes Officer JASON MOSZER's patrol vehicle, which was parked in the alley north of the subject residence near 10th Avenue. Officer JASON MOSZER reports he is in the alley north of the subject house and heard two (2) shots that sounded like they came from the subject house.
12.	9:08 p.m.	Officers are advised over the police radio that SWAT is moving in to the Sanford Same Day Surgery area, referring to the Immediate Action (IA) Team in the BearCat. Officers are advised over the police radio that they are authorized to shoot the subject if it is safe to do so.
13.	9:09 p.m.	MARCUS SCHUMACHER shoots at Trooper Malafa, who is positioned south of the subject residence near his patrol car in the alleyway near 8th Avenue North. Trooper Malafa is not injured.
14.	9:11 p.m.	MARCUS SCHUMACHER fired four (4) shots towards Officer JASON MOSZER.
15.	9:11 p.m.	The IA Team pulls up to the southeast corner of the Sanford Same Day Surgery building located to the southwest of the subject residence.
16.	9:12 p.m.	
17.	9:14 p.m.	The SWAT Team incident command center arrives at the incident command post located at First Lutheran Church.
18.	9:18 p.m.	
19.	9:19 p.m.	
20.	9:19 p.m.	Dispatch advises over the police radio that they have received multiple calls about an officer down in the alleyway near a light blue garage located north of the subject residence near 305 9th Avenue North.
21.	9:20 p.m.	Dispatch is directed to do a status check of all officers on scene. When dispatch calls Unit Edward 143, Officer JASON MOSZER's unit number, Officer JASON MOSZER does not respond.

22.	9:23 p.m.	The IA Team in the BearCat leaves the Sanford Same Day Surgery parking lot and travels northbound in the alleyway past the subject residence to perform an officer down rescue of Officer JASON MOSZER. As the BearCat is traveling past the subject residence, Officer Joe (Joseph) Johnson calls out over the police radio, "Officer down."			
23.	9:26 p.m.	The IA Team in the BearCat, assisted by Officer Joe Johnson, completes the officer down rescue. The IA Team in the BearCat travels out of the alley toward the Sanford Emergency Room with Officer JASON MOSZER. It is later reported that MARCUS SCHUMACHER fired at the IA Team in the BearCat during the officer down rescue.			
24.	9:26 p.m.	The IA Team arrives at the Sanford Emergency Room with Officer JASON MOSZER.			
25.	9:29 p.m.	The IA Team in the BearCat returns to the southeast corner of the Sanford Same Day Surgery building. SWAT Sniper JERROD WAGNER deploys from the BearCat and takes up a sniper position in the Scandia Hotel north parking lot.			
26.	9:33 p.m.	The first (1st) SWAT Tactical groups are dropped off on perimeter.			
27.	9:42 p.m.	Witness Weston Junior calls 911 and reports his vehicle was just struck by a bullet in the 300 block of 10th Avenue North. SWAT Officer Tyler Nord was standing next to Weston Junior's vehicle, which was stopped near Officer JASON MOSZER's patrol car, when the vehicle was shot by MARCUS SCHUMACHER.			
28.	10:17 p.m.	SWAT begins firing CS gas rounds into subject residence.			
29.	10:19 p.m.				
30.	10:26 p.m.	SWAT Sniper Officer JERROD WAGNER fires two (2) rounds from his sniper position. SWAT Sniper Officer JERROD WAGNER reports an unconfirmed hit on the subject			
		No additional rounds were fired by MARCUS SCHUMACHER after he was shot by SWAT Sniper JERROD WAGNER.			
31.	10:29 p.m.	Detective Swan still has an open phone line with MARCUS SCHUMACHER, but MARCUS SCHUMACHER is no longer communicating with Detective Swan.			
32.	11:38 p.m.	Officers begin conducting welfare checks on the neighboring residences.

38.	4:56 a.m.	The Grand Forks SWAT robot is deployed to the front door of the subject residence.	
39.	5:12 a.m.	The BearCat is utilized to attempt to move the screen door so the robot can gain access to subject residence.	
40.	5:46 a.m.	Red River Valley SWAT officers utilize rifle rated shields to attempt to place the robot inside the subject residence.	
41.	5:50 a.m.	Red River Valley SWAT officers, who were attempting to place the robot inside the subject residence, report a body lying face down, on the floor inside the subject residence.	
42.	5:51 a.m.	Red River Valley SWAT officers begin a search of the subject residence to secure the residence.	
43.	6:01 a.m.	Red River Valley SWAT officers indicate the subject residence is secured. Medic Kelsey Bodvig confirms MARCUS SCHUMACHER is deceased inside the subject residence. SWAT officers maintain security of the subject residence.	
44.	6:35 a.m.	The Search Warrant is signed for the subject residence.	
45.	7:14 a.m.	Custody of the subject residence and exterior crime scenes are turned over to the North Dakota Bureau of Criminal Investigation (NDBCI) for crime scene processing.	
46.	2:22 p.m.	The NDBCI completes crime scene processing of the subject residence and exterior crime scenes.	
47.	3:15 p.m.	Custody of the subject residence is released to the family of MARCUS SCHUMACHER.




